5-3 PERIODIC REPORT

No. 7.

MAP: BATALE MAP, NEGROS ISLAND; 1,50,000.

- 1. LOGATION OF THOORS: No change.
- 2. WEATHER AND VISIBELITY: Very warm, visibility unlimited.
- 3. OUR OPELATIONS:
 - a. Infantry: "E" Co., on combet patrol in the vicinity of SIMATPANPAN (36.0-07.5), observed an estimated 100 energy in the vicinity of (37.5-06.7). Artillery brought to bear landed in the target area and the energy scattered to the mills. Casualties were estimated at 20. Resupplied by air "E" Co. continued petrolling the area with mil energy contect; however, there were many indications of recent occupation of the area by the dectroyed eclipment and abandoned dug in positions. A group of approximately 100 Flippino civilians mere contacted evacuation from the Mills in the vicinity of GANCILAVAN (36.8-09.7). This group reported the enery to have mithdrean into the milis to the southeast. A combat patrol to (37.0-01.8), (37.5-02.9) and (37.5-01.5) reported abandoned enery positions vicinity (37.0-01.8) which contained a great quantity of rice and sugar, one air corps .50 cal. MG, one 20 101 gun with 500 rounds of assanition for both guns. All were destroyed. The body of one of our KIA of 13 Apr. was recovered. Combat patrol to (35.7-03.0) reports all neg tive. Reconnelssance natrol south to (84.9-99.1) reported mil contact but signs of energy occupation four or five days old.
 - b. Artillery: Harrassing fire in the area contained in coordinates (37.9-98.1) (38.1-97.8) (39.0-98.6) (38.5-99.3) delivered during might 13-14. Support fire on enemy positions and suspected positions at (30.7-97.7) (39.1-97.2) (39.3-98.1) (38.9-97.7) (39.6-98.7) (38.6-98.6)(39.1-04.4). (11 positions were Rormard of our lines and results other tion Landing in correct area could not be determined.
 - c. Engineers: Maintained supply routs road to forward elements. Provided mine search unit for tennes one mine only found.
 - d. During an air strike forward of our front line positions one A-30 sirplane fell approximately one and a balf siles to our left front. Reason undetermined but reports indicate due to energy action.
