S-3 PERIODIC REPORT

No. 9.

MAP: BATTLE MAP, NEGROS ISLAND; 1/50,000.

- 1. LOCATION OF TROOPS: See Overlay.
- 2. WRATHER AND VISIBILITY: Warm, scattered clouds.
- 3. OUR OPERATIONS: All patrols reporting after close of 161600 hour period magative. Nil action night 16-17. The RCT resumed the attack to the southeast at 0600 hour. The advance progressed 2500 yards against relatively light opposition. Tanks advancing with the forward elements were halted due to craters. A bulldozer brought forward to fill in the craters was demolished by a land mine, injuring one. The road forward is heavily cratered and two tank traps have been located. Heavy energy opposition from mitually supporting bunkers and emplacements is being met at the close of the period. We are engaging the enemy with machine gun, morter, artillery and rifle fire. "E" Go., 503d RCT, and "K" Go., 74th G-F Inf., located at SIMATPANAN continued patrolling that area with mil contact at close of period. One platoon "E" Co. was proceeding to SAN ISIDRO to investigate after a civilian report of enemy located there was received. An overnight combat patrol of "I" Co., 74th G-F Inf. and one platoon "D" Co. depart-ed 0800 hour to establish and ambush and to reconnoiter the area in vicinity (39.0-02.5). Petrol reached MANSIGUIO (37.2-01.7) with nil contact 14301. A reconneissance patrol from Go. "I" located and abandoned enemy dump at (36.5-01.5). Dump contained sugar, tinned goods, and demolition bombs and fuses. All demolition stores were destroyed. Food will be salvaged. Security patrols assigned the mission of reconnoitering draws paralleling the RCT route of advance made nil energy contact.
 - b. Artillery: Harrassing fire night of 16-17. Support on coordinates (39.3-96.7), enery bunker and (39.7-97.0) where enery was sighted on hill. A short round during this mission killed 3 and injured 5 of our troops.
 - c. Engineers: Maintanence of supply route road including bridge repair, mine detecting (5 disarmed). One bulldozer demolished by land mine.
- 4. RESULTS OF OFERATIONS: Our forward elements had moved forward approximately 2500 yards and were in contact with a well dug in energy at the close of the period. Rifles and a few machine guns are the only wempons encountered thus far, however these are more numerous than previous encounters. Our left flank patrol has encovered no evidence of energy trying to escape to the morth.
