- 1. LOCATION OF TROOPS: See overlay for changes.
- 2. MATHER AND VISIBILITY: Beavy rain, visibility very limited.
- 3. OUN OFERATIONS:
  - a. Infantry:

lst En: "A" and "B" Co patrols working towards MALAGO RIVER reached their objectives at (41.2-96.7) and (40.6-00.0) respectively at about 0210001 with nil contacts. The "A" Co patrol reported a ford at (41.2-98.7) as having been well used. There was nil activity throughout the En during night of 02-03. "B" Co, remaining in the TAIAP area overnight, continued to patrol the MALAGO RIVER 03 May from (39.7-00.1) to (41.0-99.7) with nil cantact. An "A" Co patrol exploited the draw from its position to the MALAGO RIVER (41.2-98.7) with nil contact. A "C" Co patrol penetrated thick lantana weed to the MALAGO RIVER at (41.5-97.1) with nil contact. "B" Co was returning to the En area as the pariod closed, See overlay for position.

2d Bn: 4 figure running towards "F" Co's position at 022230 was fired upon by "F" Co. At caylight 03 kay a body of what appeared to be a half-cast Jananese, 15-10 years of agr, HDS found about 10 yas from the front line. A torn piece of white ciota tied to a branch was found near the body. It is bolieved the enery mes atventing to surrender. No, weapons of any kind were on or near the body. No other activity during the night. 1 "" Co patroi observed 2 bonfires and heard movement in a draw vicinity (40.4-90.4) at 031200 hour. Surprise mortar fire was brought to bear on the area; however, torrential rains made entry into the draw impossible for investi ation as period closed. """ to sent a platcon to (4.9-90.5) for the purpose of establishing a strong point and to patrol to the Maine slvan. Hil contact to close of perion. As the O2 period closed mortar fire was being placed in vicinity (10.9-96.1). An "F" Co patrol sent to determine the rosultssaw five energy run fronthe area. Two were killed but the others e caped in the heavy-underbrush. Reconneissance of the position showed abandoned forholes only.

(3) 3d kn: Under cover of derivess "G" Co moved to (30.5-00.1) in an attempt to surprise any enemy making an early morning nove in the sidial block area. There was nil enemy activity in the in area curing the night 02-03. "G" Co patrolled the Kalado block area in vicinity (10.1-9.10) without contact.

- 4. ADDLTD OF OFFICITIONS: Extensive patrolling with nil contect in the TALL area. Contact four hundred yards to the SE of our front lines indicate continued withdrawal of energy's main forces leaving delaying parties along our route of advance.
