S-3 PERIODIC REPORT

1. LOCATION OF TROOPS: See overlay.
2. WEATHER AND VISIBILITY: Generally overcast.
3. OUR OPERATIONS:
 - a. Infantry:

(1) 1st Bn: One enemy was killed within "C" Co's perimeter night 08-09, otherwise, no activity in Bn. "A" Co patrolling to the N of MALACU RIVER reported no evidence of recent enemy action in that area. A "B" Co patrol with the mission of attempting a left flank movement in the TAYAP area reached (41.2-99.7) at 1400 with nil contact. This is an overnight patrol. A "C" Co combat patrol encountered and killed two enemy vicinity (42.0-98.4) when advancing toward the ridge (41.9-99.1). Mil report from this patrol after 1200 hr.

(2) 2d & 3d Bn: Companies of both Bn's engaged in patrolling as shown on overlay. No new evidences of enemy occupation in the areas South-eastmost of the ROT forward elements were found.

- b. Artillery: One fire mission (TAYAP area) and harrassing fire night 08-09 comprised the Artillery's activity for the period.
- c. Engineers: Maintenance of supply route under the severe handicap of heavy rains employed the Engineers during the period.
- d. Misc: Twelve caves were sealed during the period.

4. RESULTS OF OPERATIONS: Continued patrolling of the entire area uncovered no evidence of enemy concentrations to the SW.
