- 1. LOGATION OF TROOPS: See overlay.
- 2. WEATHER AND VISIBILITY: Intermittent heavy rains, continuous overcast, visibility very limited.
- 3. OUR OPERATIONS:
  - a. Infantary:
    - (1) Let Bu: Hil activity night of 13-14. Be displaced forward beginning 140830X to position shown on overlay. Isteral patrolling along the adjacent draws resulted in mil contact or evidence of any provious energy occupation.
    - (2) 2d Bn: An "E" Co recco, patrol reported observing two unarmed energy in vicinity (39,0-89,8); The energy disappeared into the heavy undergrowth and could not be relocated. Bil activity night of 13-14. An "E" Co patrol reported the "SECRET TRAIL" to be hearing W at (38,3-90,5). Patrol found one weak ald energy dead in this vicinity. Several "bangai" sticks were found in an old bivouse area near the body. No energy emplacements were observed. Faint trails leading toward HILL 1055 roccoed. with mil contact. At close of period "F" Co was displacing forward with objective vicinity (39,0-89,8).
  - b. Artillery: Continued survey for fature fire missions and one fire support mission during the period.
  - 6. Engineers: Construction and improvement of supply route and construction of waterpoints
- 4. RESULTS OF OPERATION: Extensive patrolling to the immediate 8 and 8E of HILL 1055 did not disclose any enemy emplacements in that langthe
