- 2. WEATHER AND VISIBILITY: Cool, heavy overcast and intermittent rain. Visibility limited.

3. OUR OPERATIONS:

a. Infantry:


- (1) let Bus Nil activity night 20-21. The Bu began a general advance toward its objective ridge (lk.0-12.0). "A" Co returned from the right flank and will act as guard and guide along the supply route. A "B" Co patrol advanced NZ along the base of HILL 1055 and at close of period had reached vicinity (13.4-11.5). One enemy of a group of three was killed when encountered vicinity (13.3-11.4). The other two escaped to the east. "O" On reinferred, moved N and E and at close of the period had advanced to (lk.5-11.1) with nil contact.
- (2) 2d Bn: "D" Co was withdrawn to vicinity (15.5-10.3) to permit aerial and field artillery bombardment vicinity (15.95-10.7). This day-long bombardment was in preparation for a push to the ridge (15.95-10.7) 22 May. In "F" Co security patrol to vicinity (13.5-11.3) reported nil activity.
- ortillery: Continuous harrassing fire placed on ridge (lh.7-12.1)-(15.8-0.5) during the period, in addition to a Divisional Artillery time on arget mission in same area.
- c. Engineers: Continued improvement and maintenance of supply route. Clearing of emplacements for multiple 50 cal MG and 90 MM game.
- e. A 210800 air strike was on target vicinity (15.5-11.5).
- f. One 50 cal multiple MG and one 90 MM rifle attached to RCT and went into positions (12.3-10.7) and (12.3-10.6) respectively.
- RESULTS OF OPERATIONS: Riements of the 1st Ba advanced towards the ECT objective meeting little enemy resistance. Aerial and artillery conducted a day-long soft-ening bombardment on the objective in preparation for a manual pass.
