

- 1. LOCATION OF THOOPS: See overlay.
- 2. MEATHER & VISIBILITY: Cloudy, with limited visibility and threatening rain.
- 3. OUR OPERATIONS:
  - a. Infentry:

lst Bn: "B" & "C" Co's had mil activity for the might. "A" Co had an attempted infiltration of their perimeter at about 0100. Estimated enemy strength to have been 1-6. One round of knee morter landed in the perimeter. Enemy dispersed as they received fire. Results of enemy suffered casualties unknown. At 0830 one enemy scaled cliff on "A" Co's left flank. He was killed in the attempt. "B" Co patrol to 5 went 75 feet beyond their perimeter & received fire fr two enemy. The fire was returned and one enemy killed. The patrol then continued SE to vic (16.1-11.0) and received fire fr three enemy. The patrol returned the fire and killed two enemy. Five or six enemy were observed attempting to encircle the patrol an the surrounding high ground. The patrol fired on the enemy killing one then withdrew & placed 60-mm morter in the area to force them into the draw & then place 81-mm morter into the draw. This action was taking place as the period closed.

(2) 2d Bo: Wil activity for the might. "F" Co security petrol vic (15.15-11.4) reported five recently built & evacuated 8'x 10' frame shacks believed to have been used as aid stations. Another "F" Co patrol reported well beaten trail running due N & S. Yellow communication wire observed running along the trail. The patrol cut the wire in several places. The patrol shearved four enemy vic (15.65-11.15), fired on them. killing one. The patrol withdrew because of receiving heavy is & rifle fire ir remaining three energy. This position believed to have been an enery 0:. Another "F" Co patrol observed & fired on three enery & believed they killed one. Luring the fire fight much novement in undergrowth & shaking of trees indicated that several more enemy were in the area. The three above mentioned patrol actions took place fr 301500 May until durkness set in. A \*D\* Co p local security patrol reported mil activity. """ Co set up two ambushes at (15.6-11.25) & (15.5-11.20). Seven ener. KII found in this vicinity believed to have been killed during yesterdays arty fire in this area. Four rifles also found near the bodies a mere destroyed by our troops. "?" Co observed encay fires approximately 200 yes E of their position. They could not investigate it because of our strikes that were taking place. An arty concentration was laid on ridge (15.165-11.5)-(15.6-11.9). At close of barrage "7" Co advances one platoon into the vic. The astimated 20-25 energy encountered in a bale fire fight vic (15.65-11.4). Three energy were falled.

- (3) 3d Bm: Hil activity during the might. Extensive patrolling (two overnight) S & E of RCT Sector with nil activity for the period.
- b. Artillery: Fired harrassing fire throughout the period. Marked targets for the air strikes. Fired preparation fire for Inf advance. Total of 615 rounds expended during the period.
- c. Engineers: Continued maintenance & building of supply route.
- 4. RESULTS OF OFERITIONS: Fatrols observed small groups of enemy stragglors that they killed in small brief fire fights.
- 5. DITHIBLE OPERATIONS FOR 1 JUNE: Continue patrolling to S & E of HCT Sector and within HCT Area. Continue advance towards HILL 1055 & SE to HILL 3355.
- 6. GLSUALTIES:
  - a. Our Casualties for the Period: No change.
  - b. Enery Known Casualties for the Period: 16 KIL.
