
MAP: HEMLOC I. PHOTO #28; 1/25,000.

1. LOCATION OF TROOPS: See overlay.
2. WEATHER & VISIBILITY: Cloudy, limited visibility, intermittent rains, cool.
3. OUR OPERATIONS:
 - a. Infantry:

1st Bn: Nil activity during the night. An "A" Co patrol moved to vic (16.2-11.2) and set up a small perimeter. They sent out a small patrol party to vic (16.4-11.2) and heard voices in the area. The patrol returned and brought mortar to bear in the area & found a few enemy emplacements and 2 pairs of shoes. A "B" Co patrol to vic of (16.1-11.0) had not been heard from as the period closed. A "C" Co patrol (16.1-11.5) reported nil contact at close of the period.


2d Bn: Nil activity during the night. "D" Co sent out local security patrols with nil activity. "E" Co set up two ambushed, one on the right & one on the left front of their present position with nil activity. "F" Co moved their CP to (15.7-11.4). An "P" Co recon patrol N along ridge fr their CP. The patrol found one enemy tent, two (2) medical supply boxes, one tin roof hut & two (2) grass huts, one shallow grave, one enemy dead, completely stripped of all clothing. The patrol heard movement along slope to their right. They withdrew & brought mortar fire to bear in the area as the period closed.

(3) 3d Bn: Nil activity during the night. All activity consisted of local security patrols with nil activity.
 - b. Artillery: Fired harassing fire throughout the period, marked targets for air strike. 120 rounds of ammunition expended during the period.
 - c. Engineers: Continued improvements & maintenance of supply route.
4. RESULTS OF OPERATIONS: Continued patrolling towards HILL 1055 & E of HILL 3355 with nil activity.
5. INTENDED OPERATIONS FOR 3 JUNE: Continue patrolling of ECT Sector & continue advance E of HILL 3355.
6. CASUALTIES : 2 enemy found dead.
